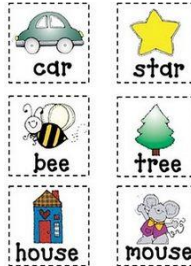

Wow!! Everyone looked amazing in their pjama's to help raise money for Children in Need and the cakes were very yummy, thank you very much for your support ☺

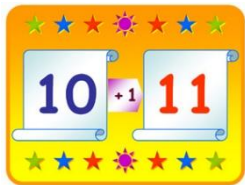
Rhyming

The children have found rhyming tricky this week. To help them practise we are sending home rhyming pairs. Can your child cut out and match the pairs up? Can they think of their own rhyming word to create a rhyming string i.e. bat, hat, mat, cat or hot, pot, dot, got not. You might like to write these words down and send them in on 'Wow' post its so we can share them and create our own rhyming bank.



1 more

We have been counting out groups of objects this week and have been using strategies to help us count them accurately including: placing them into a line, moving the objects as we count, touching the objects, counting 1 object at a time and using our knowledge of the order of numbers i.e. 1, 2, 3, 4. Can you say a number and see if your child can tell you what one more would be? We have been practising and they understand it is adding 1 more to the number they have and that the number gets bigger.



Finger Skills Gym 2

To enable your child to become a great writer, we aim to develop their fine motor skills in preparation for learning to write. This week, we have sent home more games that we would like you to practise daily with your child. You may just pick one of the games which is your child's favourite or focus on a finger game that your child finds tricky.



Home learning ideas

We recommend that you read daily with your child and have added a number of extra optional home learning ideas that you might like to do during the week...

Count forwards and backwards to 20	
Read a book to your child or let them read/tell you a story	
Encourage your child to be independent in getting their shoes and socks on, doing up their zip or buttons	
Practise hearing and saying rhyming words	
Go around the home and count out objects accurately (upto 20)
