

HOMEWORK SHEET For Year 3 and 4

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Round up



Each week, two of our children will write the round up. This week it was the turn of Owen Moore and Harriet Ilbrey (Pine Marten).

In maths we have been solving money problems and we've been learning different methods, thinking about which one is quickest. We have been using some rich vocabulary in English as well as using prepositions and expanded noun phrases to write about a Viking story setting. In Science we have been learning about forces and magnets. In P.E. we have been creating Viking boats with our bodies using our gymnastics skills such as rolls and balances.

Coming up



In this section, the teachers will signpost next week's learning, with suggestions so you can support your child.

In English we will be developing our descriptive writing skills further and focusing on describing Viking warriors towards our Viking story. In Maths we will be working with data. This will include interpreting bar graphs and tally charts. You could consider creating graphs of your own at home. This could be to collate games scores or information about being physically active. We will be using our understanding of forces, including magnets to discover more about Viking travel.

- Expanded noun phrases (adjective + noun, for example gloomy forest)
- Prepositions (words to tell you the location of a noun, for example 'The warrior sat on the fallen log.'
