Expressive Arts & Design

PE

Dance:

- Linked to the theme of The Vikings. Listen to different music and create moves linked to the activities of the Vikings.

Create:

- Dynamic balance and coordination along with ball skills.

Music

- Learn to play the ukulele.
- Perform Viking songs with percussion and ukulele e.g. Longship round.

Story writing:

- Describe the setting of a Viking story and describe the actions of the Viking character.

Grammar:

- Using adverbs, inverted commas and fronted adverbials in fictional writing.
- Using conjunctions and understanding present and past tense.

Maths

- Continue to develop number fluency by calculating mentally to solve addition and subtraction problems.
- Use times tables to solve multiplication and division problems.
- Use calculation to solve practical mathematical problems.
- Measure and compare length, mass and capacity.

History

- Viking raids and invasion, the struggle for the kingdom of England.

Science

Forces and Magnets:

- Testing the effect of movement on different surfaces.
- Investigating how magnets attract and repel and how this could speed up or slow down the launching of our Viking Ships.

- Using Scratch to program a Viking character to move, talk and make sounds.
