<p><b>Round up</b></p> 	<p>Each week, two of our children will write the round up. In science we investigated different materials to find out whether they were conductors or insulators of electricity.</p>

Practising rapid recall of addition and subtraction facts can help with this. In English we will be starting to learn about information texts, using a variety of books about penguins.</p>				
<p><b>Homework</b></p> 	<p>The homework for half term is to make a penguin! Be as creative as you like. If you need some inspiration you could ask a grown-up to help you search the internet, there are lots of fantastic ideas.</p> <p>You could also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write about any maths you've used while making your penguin.</li> <li>• Write a set of instructions for making the penguin.</li> <li>• Write a story about your penguin.</li> <li>• Research penguin facts</li> </ul>				
<p><b>Times tables</b></p> 	<p>Practise saying your times tables facts aloud. Try timing yourself to see how long it takes you to get to 12 x that number.</p>	<p><b>Spellings</b></p> 	<p>Look at your spellings on the back of the list and also from the year 3/4 spelling list.</p>	<p><b>Reading</b></p> 	<p>What interesting non-fiction books can you find to read?</p>
