Can you sketch these?</p>	<p>Make a list of digital devices in your home that can record sound (audio).</p>	<p>Have you ever found a fossil? Find out about locations in the UK where fossils might be found.</p>
<p>What are the important rules of hockey? Can you find out about any famous hockey players?</p>	<p>Find out about Podcasts. What are they? Who makes them? What are they about? Ask a grownup if you can listen to some podcasts for children.</p>	<p>Create a fact file about a person who has inspired you. Find out about any challenges they have overcome. Do they give any good advice for being resilient?</p>	<p>Create a timeline of events which you think are important or interesting. How far back will you go?</p>

Can you categorise them? (Hint: Minecraft might give you the names of a variety of rocks!)</p>	<p>Write a timetable of your day using analogue and digital time. E.g. Quarter past seven (07:15) Eat breakfast 8 o'clock (08:00) Leave for school</p>	<p>Dreams and Goals. Draw pictures of what you think you may be doing at age 16, 26 and 55 and include a timeline.</p>
