



Reading

- Read, Write Inc – Children will read in school every day and bring either a reading book or sheet home to share each day.
- Listening to and discussing stories at a level beyond that at which they can read independently.

Writing

- Key Texts: **No-Bot the Robot & Hidden World Oceans (non-fiction)**
- Children will learn to write simple sentences with the main focus being on full stops, capital letters and finger spaces.
- Using 'est'
- And joining words and joining clauses using "and"

How I can help my child this term:

- Practice writing simple sentences with a capital letter, a full stop and finger spaces between words. Can you try this independently?
- Practice playing games and taking turns at home
- Lead-in letters in preparation for Year 2
- Spellings (sent out every term) – particularly Year 1 Common Exception Words.
