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## Round up



Each week, two of our children will write the round up. This week it was the turn of Esther and Max (Hare class)

This week we have each been creating a new species of animal to live in the Rainforest. We have explored food chains and collected technical vocabulary to support writing of our information texts next week. On Tuesday we made Christmas cards and on Thursday, Pine Martens and Hares focused on tennis skills while Foxes practiced their rainforest moves with gym equipment. In Maths, both Year 3 and 4 have been using the column method with renaming.

Next week, in maths Year 3 and Year 4 will continue with subtraction, moving on to renaming with column method. In English we will begin to write our information text about animals which live in the rainforest.
