English

The children have been working hard in presenting their writing in the style of 'Anatomy – a cutaway look inside the human body', with diagrams and lift up tabs. We are looking forward to adding these to a display this week.

Maths

The children have been comparing and converting volume in both metric and imperial measures as well as solving problems involving volume and reviewing their learning. Next week, the children will be learning how to write Roman Numerals, and then solve problems using them.

Topic

Next week, the children will do a short DT topic - testing, designing, making and then evaluating healthy bread rolls. They will have the chance to taste lots of different types and flavours of bread rolls, evaluate them comparing their tastes, textures and smells before designing their own bread roll, making it and then evaluating it against a design brief. School will provide the basic bread making ingredients but any other additional ingredients will need to be provided by the children.
