

Key Stage 1 Home Learning

This week, we've been:

- Writing about Little Red Riding Hood using statements and questions (Year 2).
- Learning how to open applications and manipulate windows on a computer.
- Ask your child to tell you more!

Choose from the following activities:

Year 2: Can you share some of our addition and subtraction methods with your adults at home? (number bonds/partitioning, number lines, column method.) Can you tell them what exchanging and renaming means?

Year 1: Can you practise adding by counting on from the biggest number? Create some addition problems to solve!

Year 1 and 2: Can you think of all the things you 'do' over the weekend. What verb describes your action? Can you use your verb in a sentence? E.g. eat - I eat tea with my family.

General Notices: On a Wednesday afternoon your child is taught specialised P.E. and music sessions whilst their class teachers have PPA. They are sent home by these same adults. To help the team at home time on this day in particular, could we please ask all adults who are collecting, to be extra vigilant and support the team in identifying you when waiting outside the classrooms. This will ensure every teacher is confident they are sending the children home with a known, familiar adult.

We have not affixed the designs in school as we understand children may wish to add to them at home, or you may have a design you'd prefer to create at home together.
