Eg: My Daddy is taller than my Mummy. Can you write some of these statements in your book?

Year 1 and 2:

Find out some information about Amelia Earhart. Use the sheet on the back of this page to help record some facts you find out about her to contribute to our learning in English.

Who was she? What did she do? How did she learn to fly? Where did she go? What did you learn from her?

You could also make a list of questions that you could ask Amelia Earhart if you ever had the chance to speak to her. Use the questions words - Who? What? When? Where? Why? and How? to support you.
