

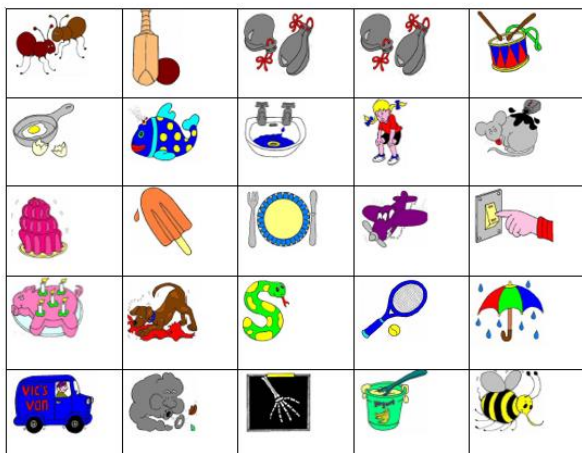


Foundation Stage News

Home learning ideas

We recommend that you read daily with your child and have added a number of extra optional home learning ideas that you might like to do during the week...	✓
Can your child recognise and name the four basic 2D shapes (square, rectangle, square and circle)	
Read a book to your child or let them read/tell you a story	
Practise forming letters from previous weeks and from their bookmarks	
Practise hearing and saying initial sounds in words (the first sound you hear)	
Go around the home and count out objects accurately (up to 20)	
Practise forming numbers and showing different ways of creating the same number.	
Play on phonics play.	
Practise zipping up their coat, putting their socks and shoes on independently.	
Practise writing their name
