Read, Write Inc - Children will read in school every day and bring both a paper copy and a book bag home to read for the week.

Writing

Children will learn to use subordinate and coordinate conjunctions as well as the correct form of the past tense verb.

Computing - Programming Quizzes

This unit initially recaps on learning from the Year 1 Scratch Jr unit 'Programming B-Programming animations'. Children begin to understand that sequences of commands have an outcome, and make predictions based on their learning. They use and modify designs to create their own quiz questions in Scratch Jr, and realise these designs in Scratch Jr using blocks of code.

PE - Dance

Children will learn to perform to a dance sequence they have created collaboratively using a range of movements.

Position and Direction: Children will learn to Order and arrange combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences.
