Maths	<p>Counting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the 10's frame, count objects and record how many there are by drawing the objects in the 10's frame and writing the number next to it. (these were sent home to use last week, you can draw them in your book if you need more) Estimating how many objects they can see i.e. how many pencils are in the pot, how many DVD's are in the cupboard. Then count them. Practising counting, forwards and backwards and ordering numbers from 1-10, then 10-20. Remove a number which number is missing?
Writing	<p>Exploring books</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read a story. Can you draw pictures to show what has happened in the story? Can you draw a story map? Can you draw the characters in the story? Can you label them using your sounds? Can you change the ending of the story? What could have happened?
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reading is key. Continue to explore the books we have sent home and also ones you have at home. Read to your child, let your child read to you or their siblings. Explore the games on phonics play www.phonicsplay.co.uk Use the username: march20 and password: home to have access to all the games. Explore games in Phase 2, 3 and 4.
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise reading the 'tricky' words on your bookmarks. Can you put the tricky word into your own sentence? Can you write it down?
Handwriting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you practise writing your letter shapes? (see attached letter shapes) Can you practise writing words using the digraphs and trigraphs? (See attached word list)
Other areas of learning	<p>Explore your garden</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you draw the minibeast you find? Can you make a tally to record how many of each minibeast you found? Can you write the number of minibeasts you find? Can you label the minibeasts you find? Can you write facts about the minibeasts you find?
