

Year 4 Summer 1 Home Learning Tasks

We will be learning about 'Earthquakes' in Geography, 'Arabia and Early Islam' in History and exploring 'The message Jesus spreads' in RE. We will also be looking at 'Sound' in Science, 'Relationships' in PSHE and the artist 'Henri Rousseau' in Art. We will be practising Tennis for outdoor PE and looking at creating a rainforest Dance for our indoor PE. Our PE days will now be on Wednesday for Hares and Wednesdays for Otters (indoor) and Fridays for both classes (outdoor). For English this term, we will be looking at a myth and legend about a precious stone followed by a non-fiction text based on rainforests.

Within our Maths learning, we will continue learning about Decimals, money and telling the time.

Each week you can choose one or two activities from the grid below. This part of your home learning should take no longer than 1 hour. Please continue to enjoy plenty of reading and quizzes at home. Well done, keep up the hard work!

We have now taught and learned all of the times tables up to 12×12 and the expectation at this point is that they know their times tables off-by-heart. Please can we ask you to support them at home by identifying any tables which they don't know quite so well and practice these. TT rockstars will focus on the times tables that your child needs based on their interaction. Please encourage short periods of practice at least three times a week. This will be monitored and time in school will also be given. There is also a battle between both Year 4 classes every week. Every question counts!

Reading at home, every day is crucial for overall development. Please ensure that you are enjoying books with your children every day. This could be their reading book from school or home.

This term they are revising some of the spelling they have done this year. They will be tested on a Monday and expected to be practising at home.
