## 10 Different ways to help me learn my spellings

1. Fancy letters - write each of your spelling words using fency letters.
2. Connect the dots - write your spelling words in dots and then join the dots together.
3. Draw your spellings - araw a picture of the spelling and then label it.
4. Colourful words - Write each letter of your spellings words in a different coloured pencil e.g. answer.
5. Pyramid writing - write your spelling words adding a letter each time to make a pyramid shape

B. UPPER and lower - write your spelling words two times each. First, write each word in UPPERCASE letters. Then, write each word in lower case letters.
e.g. ANSWER answer
6. Other Handed - First write your spelling words the way you usually hold your pen or pencil. Then, try writing the list with your other hand.
