

Maths



This week the children have been introduced to rekenreks. They have learnt how to use them and have practised showing different amounts.

Use a large die to play a matching game. When the die is rolled, ask the children to say the number shown without counting. How do they know? Can they match the quantity on the die with a different representation (e.g. a number plate or dot card to 5)? If you have a blank die or a small plain box you could make your own die with non-standard arrangements of dots.

Can you make your own subitising cards using paper and pens to show different arrangements of dots e.g.  and play a matching number game?
