Read, Write Inc - Children will read in school every day and bring both a paper copy and a book bag home to read for the week.

Writing

Children will learn to write questions and commands. Children will learn to use the suffixes 'ful' and 'ly' and revisit the 'ed' suffix. Children will write sentences using the subordinating conjunction 'if'. Children will revisit expanded noun phrases.

Computing - Data Information and Pictograms

We will:

- Recognize and compare objects using a tally chart.
- Recognize that objects can be represented as pictures.

PE - Cricket

We will:

- Control the direction of the ball well.
- Bowl consistently in a star shape.
- Hit the ball in different areas to increase the number of runs.

Maths

Multiplication and Division: Recall multiplication and division facts for 2, 5, 10s. Solve multiplication and division problems using materials, arrays, repeated addition.

Length and height: Compare and order lengths using $>$, $<$ and $=$. Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm).

Mass, Capacity and temperature: Compare and order mass/volume/capacity using $>$, $<$ and $=$. Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure mass (kg/g); temperature and capacity
