Comments reflected that parents believe the following:

- The talk was **informative**, honest and frank
- Its presentation and delivery were excellent
- The handouts and website links were ‘invaluable’
- They now need to be ‘more vigilant’ and have ‘learnt an awful lot’ and ‘a lot I didn’t know’. They also feel they need to ‘up their game’.
- They ‘loved seeing my boy in class after.’
