Parents have the right to ask for their child to be withdrawn from the Sex Education elements of the RSE curriculum. Schools also have responsibility to teach the science national curriculum. The science curriculum includes the body parts, growth and puberty sections of our RSE curriculum. Therefore, the parental right to withdraw their child from RSE lessons is relevant in Year 5 and 6 when conception and birth is taught. If your child is in Year 5 and 6 this year and you do not want your child to be involved in these sessions, please email us.

NSPCC - Additionally the school will use materials from the NSPCC. They aim to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse in a child friendly, interactive way. We will use the Speak Out. Stay Safe assemblies for EYFS/KS1 and KS2 children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a trusted adult or Childline.

Children in EYFS KS1 and Year 3/4 will also watch and discuss the resource talk PANTS.
