



Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been lovely to meet you all on the gate in the mornings and we are very much enjoying our time at Woodlands Park.

Over the last few weeks, we have been looking at the systems and processes within the school. Moving into Term 4, we would like to inform you of some changes in and around Woodlands Park to improve the learning environments for all.

1. To enable staff to set up the outside provision ready for our Reception children to start their day's learning, we are closing this as an access walk through area. Please access all classrooms through the playground. Children in Dormice and Woodmice will continue to enter their classrooms through this area.
2. The school's behaviour policy has been reviewed to ensure clarity for all. (An updated copy of the policy will be available on the school's website next term.)
3. To support Miss. Ramsey, for 2 days a week, Mrs. Rumistrzewicz, an experienced Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Coordinator in the Trust, will be temporary joining the school. Miss. Ramsey will still be available should you need her, but will now be spending more time in the Early Years supporting staff to ensure children get off to the best possible start.
4. In KS2, there will be a slightly earlier lunchtime 12:15pm- 1:15pm to make the most out of lesson times in the mornings and afternoons. Please ensure footballs are kept at home and the school will provide these.
5. We are thrilled to welcome Mrs. Westmoreland to the teaching team. She will be working across a range of classes across the remainder of the spring and summer terms.

The Trust will give you an update as soon as possible on Mrs. Vollans absence.
