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Introduction

At Woodlands Park Primary School, we believe that wearing a school uniform promotes a sense of community, belonging, and pride. It also ensures pupils are dressed in a way that supports learning and is appropriate for school activities. This policy outlines our expectations for school uniform, how it can be purchased, and related guidance.

Uniform Expectations

Boys' Uniform

Winter Uniform – Required

- White shirt or polo shirt
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts
- Maroon sweatshirt jumper with the school logo
- Grey or white socks
- Black sensible shoes or black leather look trainers with a black logo (no colours or fabric trainers, Crocs, or boots)

Summer Uniform – Required

- White shirt or polo shirt
- Grey tailored shorts or trousers
- Sun hat (optional – school caps available via [Woodlands Park Primary School – The Uniform Company](#))

PE Kit – Required

- Maroon PE dry fit top with school logo (White T-shirt - unbranded item may be worn during introduction of PE top for 2026/7)
- Black shorts without brand/logo
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Optional: Maroon PE Hoodie with school logo
- Black jogging bottoms (unbranded items without brand/logo)

Girls' Uniform

Winter Uniform – Required

- White blouse/shirt or polo shirt
- Grey skirt, pinafore dress, or tailored grey trousers
- Maroon sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo
- White or grey socks or grey tights

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- Black sensible shoes or black leather look trainers with a black logo (no colours or fabric trainers, Crocs, or boots)

Summer Uniform – Optional

- Red and white checked dress
- OR white blouse/shirt or polo shirt with grey culottes or tailored shorts
- Sun hat (optional – school caps available via ParentPay or the school office)

PE Kit – Required

- Maroon PE dry fit top with school logo (White T-shirt - unbranded item may be worn during introduction of PE top for 2026/7)
- Black shorts without brand/logo
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Optional: Maroon PE Hoodie with school logo
- Black jogging bottoms (unbranded items without brand/logo)

Additional Uniform and Equipment

- **Reading Folders:** All pupils require a reading folder for reading books, homework, and school correspondence. This should be brought to school daily.
- **Water Bottles:** Clear, reusable water bottles should be used for hydration throughout the school day.
- **Sun Hats:** Strongly recommended in summer. Branded caps are available or pupils may bring one from home.

Jewellery and Accessories

- Only small plain earring studs and wristwatches may be worn. Smart watches are not permitted.
- Earrings should be removed for PE. If this is not possible, pupils must cover earrings with tape provided in classrooms.
- Necklaces and other jewellery are not permitted.
- The school cannot be held responsible for lost jewellery, including watches.

Hair and Appearance

- Hair must be neat and should not obstruct vision.

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- Long hair must be tied back for safety and hygiene.
- Hair accessories should be simple and functional, not used as fashion items.
- Extreme hairstyles (e.g. tramlines, mullets) and dyed hair are not permitted. Acceptable cuts include smart styles such as short back and sides with a fade (minimum grade 2 on top).
- No makeup, nail polish, fake nails, or temporary tattoos are allowed in school.

Lost Property

Lost items are initially placed in labelled boxes outside the school. Support can be requested by the school office to help find missing items. To avoid loss, please label all items clearly with your child's name.
